

How to take a sample of capillary blood







There should be good blood circulation in the hand from which you wish to take blood. Lightly massage the fingers in order to stimulate the circulation.




Only use the middle or ring finger. The patient should not wearing a ring on the sampling finger. Disinfect the puncture site and allow to dry.



Press lightly on the fingertip while puncturing the side of the fingertip with an adequate safety lancet.




Blot away the first drop of blood. Draw a second drop which is large enough to fill the cuvette completely. Avoid "milking".



Hold the Tipp of the cuvette in the middle of the drop of blood and wait until the cuvette is filled completely. DO NOT fill from the side.



Remove excess blood from the outside of the cuvette by carefully wiping off with a gauze or lint-free tissue.



Immediately insert the cuvette into the cuvette holder. Gently push the holder closed. After testing, open the cuvette holder and properly dispose of the cuvette.
